NEW FEATURES

- Automatic Disbursements for Stripe E-Payments: In previous versions of Alden One, Pro companies could utilize Stripe for payments processing to receive e-payments from their customers within their conversation workflows. Those funds were held in Alden's account and required manual disbursement requests. With this release of Alden One, the disbursements have been automated. Pro customers using the Alden One e-payment feature can now request automatic monthly disbursements of those payments to their connected Stripe accounts. Some configuration is required on the Pro customer's end to set this up. Contact your Alden account manager or project team to request more information about the Alden One E-Payment features.
- Oplit into Multiple Child Conversations of the Same Type: Alden One now allows conversations to be configured to automatically split into multiple child conversations of the same type. For example, if an attacher begins a generic Permit To Attach and adds poles owned by two different Pro companies who both utilize the core Joint Use Permit To Attach for managing the PTA process, then Alden One can split that generic PTA into two child Joint Use PTA conversations one for each pole owner.

- o **Associate Existing Pole Violations with a Pole:** In the previous release of Alden One, Pole Violations were added as assets that can be searched and managed. The ability to add a new Pole Violation to a Pole was established, and users could view the Pole Violations associated with an open Pole. In this release of Alden One, when viewing an open Pole Violation, a new Poles tab is available to quickly see and navigate to the associated Pole.
- View the Pole from an Open Pole Violation: The system has been enhanced to allow linking an existing Pole Violation to a Pole. A Pole Violation can only be linked to one Pole, but a Pole may have multiple linked Pole Violations.

BUG FIXES

BUGS FIXED THIS RELEASE

- Adding a Duplicate E-Payment Account: If a user attempted to add an E-Payment account for making payments to Pro companies, and that account had already been registered as a payment account in Alden One, the user was not informed that the account was already registered. The system has been updated to provide a helpful error message indicating that the account already exists.
- ✓ E-Payment Dialog: For some specific conversation configurations that utilize extra attributes for billable items on the Assets tab, when a user attempted to make an E-Payment, then a background error occurred that resulted in the user not seeing the charges or billable items to be paid. This issue has been addressed so that the billable items are displayed on the payment screen as expected.
