# NEW ENHANCEMENTS

## NEW ENHANCEMENTS THIS RELEASE

- **New configuration option to add Pole Violation photos to be visible on a conversation:** When a Pole Violation is added to a conversation by Task Agent or when Poles are added, the public photos that are associated with the Pole Violation will now be visible and accessible within the conversation. To access the photos, select one Pole Violation on the Poles (assets) tab and then use the option to Show Photos for Pole Violation from the Take Action menu. Alternatively, select the Assets folder in the Photos tab to see all photos for all assets on the conversation.
- **Integration API has been enhanced to disallow adding poles with duplicate LegacyIDs:** Because the LegacyID is used to synchronize data between Alden One and external systems, the API now enforces that the LegacyID be unique for a company's pole data.
- **Integration API has been updated to include a new call to get a list of all changed attachments for a specific day:** A new endpoint has been introduced (recentlymodified) to allow retrieval of Utility Pole Attachments that have been modified on a specified day within the last 3 days.

# BUG FIXES

## BUGS FIXED THIS RELEASE

- ✓ **Task Agent duplicated photos:** If a user added photos on the documents screen in Task Agent and then a revision occurs, then the photos were duplicated on the resulting conversation. The revision logic has been corrected to avoid adding duplicate photos from Task Agent.

## OTHER NOTES

### OTHER NOTES FOR THIS RELEASE

- **Searching Assets & Conversations Using Notes Text & Document Filenames:** Alden One currently includes the ability to search for assets and conversations using notes text as well as document filenames. There is a limitation on the number of notes and documents that can be indexed, along with a maximum of 250 characters from each note body. This limitation could produce search results that are not comprehensive. In an upcoming release, the ability to search for assets and conversations using the note content and document filenames may be removed to avoid confusion.
