

## Release Notes for Mini-Release 19.3.0

Walkthrough of Improvements for this release of Alden One.

## User Stories

When a pole is added to a Permit To Attach conversation, the conversation will change into the pole owner's custom permitting process, if applicable. Previously, the conversation was not changed into the custom process until the permit was submitted. This allows for more flexibility and insurance that any required data is provided by the applicant prior to its submittal.

If a Permit To Attach conversation is in the 'Split By Owner' status, the conversation will be read-only for anyone having access to it. This will ensure that the new conversations created from the 'split' will be used going forward rather than the original request.

Added the counts for Assets, Notes, Documents, and Photos when viewing a conversation on a mobile device

Prevented errors from occurring when exporting a conversation for a second time causing the entire process to halt

Prevented a user from adding a proposed attachment to a pole if the assets are read-only on a conversation

Prevented a user from removing or adding an asset if the assets are read-only on a conversation

Corrected the text that displays when changing the status of more than one conversation at a time if there are no available actions

Disabled the ability to share a role with individual users if the role was shared with everyone in the company

Prevent users from entering a phone number or email address with an unexpected format

## Bugs

Prevent a read-only user from adding a pole to a conversation from the search results

No longer show actions on the map view of a conversation that the user does not have permission to execute. Previously, an error would display after the action was executed.

Corrected the problem with labels on the map turning 'on' after being turned 'off' when 'show poles' was clicked 'off' or 'on'

Corrected the inconsistency in the visibility of asset actions on a conversation if user did not have permission to take an action

Corrected the inconsistency in the actions that displayed in the Take Action menu on a conversation when switching between the map view and the grid view

Can now get access to conversation help even if you have read-only access

Add an icon to Utility Pole Attachments tab on a open pole

The 'Remove Asset(s)' action will no longer be visible if the user does not have permission to remove assets from a conversation. Previously, an error would be received.

Selecting Run Reports as a pinned action tab will now open in a new browser tab rather than opening in the current tab.

Corrected a cosmetic issue with the conversation type list when starting a new conversation

Corrected a cosmetic issue with the SAVE button when using Alden One on a mobile device

Corrected the problem with not being able to close the search tabs when using Alden One on a mobile device

Corrected a cosmetic issue with the Menu button when using Alden One on a mobile device

Added the conversation type and conversation number to the header when viewing a conversation on a mobile device

Corrected the problem of not being able to edit the name or description of a photo uploaded to a conversation via a mobile device

Corrected the problem of not being able to edit the name or description of a photo when viewing a conversation on a mobile device

Corrected a cosmetic issue on the main menu options when using Alden One on a mobile device

Disabled the ability to re-order your favorite filters when using Alden One on a mobile device

Disabled the ability to use the custom editor when searching for conversations via an attribute when using Alden One on a mobile device

Corrected a cosmetic issue with the button that switches between the filter list and its values when using Alden One on a mobile device

Prevent a user from saving a blank note

Prevent a user from unintentionally deleting a role from a user

Prevent the '<custom attribute> ID has changed' error when saving changes on a conversation

Corrected the problem of not being able to consistently open a role from the Admin page

Prevented the user from losing their place when navigating away from the Utility Pole tab

Prevented comments from being deleted on a conversation asset when using the Line Editor

Corrected the problem of not being able to see that a role was given to a user if that role was given to everyone in the company
