NOTE: When adding photos to a pole, the following guidelines should be followed:

- a. BRSP requires at least 4 photos per pole:
 - i. Full View



- ii. Top View
- iii. Bottom View
- iv. Markings

Full View	Top View	Bottom View	Markings
			
Clear unobstructed photo of the entire pole.	Clear photo of the top of the pole.	Provide photo of the bottom of the pole during inspection.	Frame all pole markings in the photo, after any tags have been added. More than one photo may be needed to capture all.
